This communication is to notify you of changes that will be effective **September 4, 2018**. In an effort to ensure compliance with Florida’s Controlled Substance Prescribing Law (HB 21) that went into effect on July 1, 2018, and to further our work in preventing and responding to substance use disorder, Prestige Health Choice will implement the following modifications:

Schedule II Opioid Day Supply Limit

Day Supply Limit

- The day supply limit will be a maximum of three days without a prior authorization.
- Claims exceeding the day supply limit will reject with error code 69 – Exceeds Allowed Days Therapy by Plan (NCPDP Error 76 – Plan Limitations Exceeded).

Acute Pain Exemption

- Prescriptions that indicate Acute Pain Exemption will be limited to a maximum of a 7-day supply without a prior authorization.
- Claims rejecting with error code 69 will have additional messaging indicating “ACUTE PAIN USE DUR PPS CODE MX”.

Overriding the 3-Day Supply

- Step 1 – Verify the prescription indicates a diagnosis of Acute Pain
- Step 2 – Enter the following DUR PPS codes:
 1. Reason for Service Code – MX (Excessive Duration Alert)
 2. Professional Service Code – MØ (Prescriber Consulted)
 3. Result of Service Code – 1G (Filled, with Prescriber Approval)
- Step 3 – Enter Submission Clarification

Exceeding the 7-Day Supply

- Claims processed that exceed the 7-day supply after using the DUR PPS override entered will return additional messaging “Acute Pain Schedule II Limit Exceeded.”
- Use of the DUR PPS Code and the certification code will be auditable at the pharmacy level as required by the plan.

Schedule III – V Controlled Substance Day Supply Limit (for the treatment of acute pain)

Day Supply Limit

- The day supply limit will be a maximum of 7 days without a prior authorization.
 - An approved prior authorization will allow a maximum 14-day supply.
- Claims exceeding the day supply limit will reject with error code 69 – Exceeds Allowed Days Therapy by Plan (NCPDP Error 76 – Plan Limitations Exceeded).
